THE FULL DECK CHALLENGE

Since hunger is a constant year round issue, it needs to be addressed continually. Here is an easy way to do a little something each week to ensure that the Haven has food available on its shelves all the time. There are 52 cards in a deck and 52 weeks in a year. Each week we will draw a card from the deck that has been matched with one of the most requested items at the Haven. You can purchase the item and drop it in the donation box as you leave the store. Quick and easy — no worrying about what to buy or how to get it there. You decide the size, brand and number of that item you wish to donate. Here is how it works, below is what each card represents (suits don't matter)

Aces are wild – so they represent one gallon of milk and one dozen eggs.

2- Peanut butter

3- Canned tuna fish

4- Pasta

5- Canned soup

6- Pasta sauce

7- Jelly/jam

8- Chick peas 9- Cereal

10- Sliced bread Jack- Mac & cheese

Queen- Canned tomatoes King- Canned black beans

Jokers- Toss in something of your choice. You pick the

two weeks that you play your Jokers.

This challenge will start the week of January 1st – drawings will take place each Monday and will be posted on the list serve and at Dan & Whit's. For example: on Monday, January 5, 2015, a 2 of clubs is drawn, indicating that the week's item is peanut butter. At some point during the week you can donate the peanut butter. You decide the size, brand and quantity you wish to donate, purchase and drop it in the donation box. It's that simple. At the end of the year, the entire deck of cards will be used and the Haven will have received food each week. Let Dan Fraser know if you wish to participate in this challenge.
